

Safety rules!

Never touch

- A fallen branch on an electrical line
- A tree touching or in very close proximity to an electrical line
- Electrical wires fallen to the ground
- Do not approach an object within 3 meters of an electrical line
- Do not make fire under electrical lines



Fatal danger

Do not trim within 3 meters of any cables

Trim your trees to protect your home

A tree branch situated near a live electrical line can become dangerous, cause outage of power, break the cable or cause serious accident to one.



Whos is responsible for trimming?

Near your service connection cable

Your responsibility

Near network cable

UNELCO's responsibility



Call UNELCO at **26 000** to advice you on the intervention modalities

Before trimming, Service connection must be disconnected from power!

1 Meter is installed inside the property



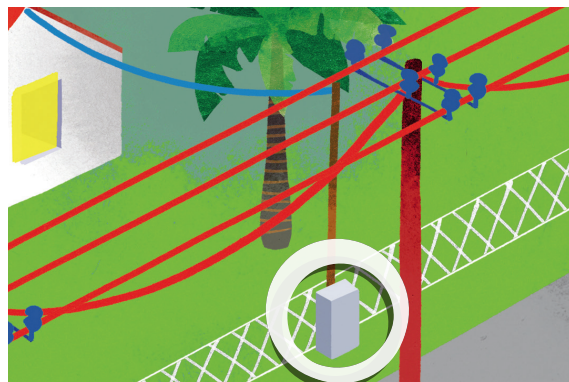
Call UNELCO for a temporary disconnection of your service connection (free for charge).



2 Meter is installed on the limit of the property



You can carry out the disconnection of your supply cable by yourself by cutting the circuit breaker.

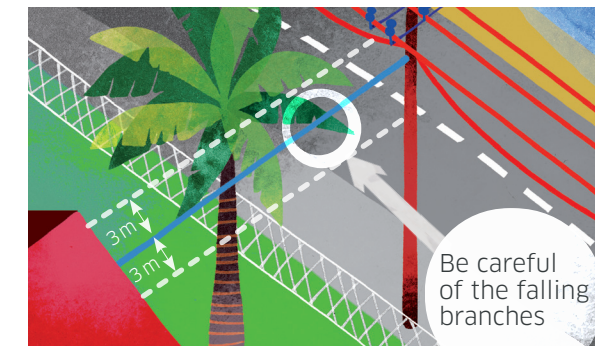


You are responsible for the trimming of vegetations around your service connection cable (see blue below)



It is forbidden for you to trim any vegetation near UNELCO network electrical line (see red arrow). Call UNELCO at 26000

Systematically maintain a minimum of 3 meters around your service connection cable



It is forbidden for you to trim any vegetation that is touching and/or on top of the service connection cable. The failing branches risks hitting the cable often results in short circuits.
